1 Story Post
 Forty-two locally-quarried granite posts bring Gloucester's mariners, artists, innovators, and interesting characters to life. In addition to the heritage and culture of the working waterfront and downtown, you'll get a glimpse of today's vibrant and diverse community. Use your smart phone to scan the QR code on each Story Post to access additional content on ghwalk.org.

A Walking Cinema
 The HarborWalk also features an award-winning collection of short films highlighting Gloucester's premier event, St. Peter's Fiesta, as well as the heroic story of Howard Blackburn. Use your smart phone to access these interactive films by scanning the QR code on posts with Walking Cinema signs, or download the "Walking Cinema" app on iTunes or Google Play.

B Postcard
 Many Story Posts contain postcards that showcase Gloucester life and culture. Use your smart phone to access the postcards through the "Walking Cinema" app. Many contain local tips, places to visit, and special promotions. You can also send a postcard to a friend at ghwalk.org.

Main Walk
 The main walk is 1.2 miles long (30 minutes) and takes you through the working waterfront and historic downtown. Do the entire walk at once, or hop on and hop off at any point. You can start anywhere along the route; however, if you are using the "Walking Cinema" app, Ann Marie (our virtual tour guide) starts at Walking Cinema post A: Fiesta!

Extended Walk
 The east extension (0.8 miles/16 minutes) takes you to Gloucester's port-of-call, Cruiseport, and one of the many Gloucester houses captured in Edward Hopper paintings. The west extension (0.8 miles/16 minutes) takes you by the Man at the Wheel statue on your way to beautiful Stage Fort Park—site of the first permanent settlement in Massachusetts, beaches, and a great playground.
